AMENDMENT #08 TO CONTRACT CS210318001

CONTRACT TITLE: Comprehensive Health Care Services

CONTRACT PERIOD: July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2028

The State of Missouri hereby desires to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. As a result of §191.1165 (7) RSMo, the State of Missouri desires to amend the contract to expand MAT services to help reduce the risk of opioid overdose; therefore, paragraphs 2.9.2 e, 2.9.2 h, and 2.9.2 h 1) are hereby deleted in their entirety and replaced as follows:

2.9.2 Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) –

- e. The contractor shall provide 3 Qualified Mental Health Providers (QMHP's) and 2 Nurse Practitioners to provide the substance use and screening tool in addition to providing consultation in treatment and adjunct supportive education and programming. The contractor's QMHP's must have the potential to be able to assess and diagnose substance use disorders to allow for the offender to receive services for substance use sooner than after the offender's incarceration period.
- h. In order to cover the cost of direction medications, testing and expanded ancillary expenditures related to the expanded MAT services and treatment during the period of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026, the state agency has a maximum \$6,684,213.02 available from the opioid settlement funds. From these funds, the state agency will allow a maximum of 15% to cover the costs to administer the expanded MAT program (*to include personnel costs*).
 - 1) The contractor shall submit monthly invoices that track, and report MAT expanded services provided, personnel expenses (except for the full-time MAT Coordinator and full-time MAT Provider), supplies, ancillary expenditures, and medications purchased. After review and approval of the invoices, the state of Missouri will reimburse the contractor up to \$6,684,213.02, with up to 15% allowable for administrative costs (*to include personnel costs*), and up to \$334,641.00 for 3 QMHP's (annually) and up to \$312,501.00 for 2 Nurse Practitioners (annually) for the period from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 for approved services provided and medications purchased for service enhancements to offenders housed in the correctional facilities.

All other terms, conditions and provisions of the contract, including pricing, shall remain the same and apply hereto.

The contractor shall signify acceptance by signing and returning this document on or before the date indicated on page one.

The Missouri Department of Corrections (DOC) has requested contract CS210318001 with Centurion of Missouri, LLC for Comprehensive Health Care Services be amended to expand Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) services.

As a result of §191.1165 (7) RSMo, the DOC requires expanded MAT services to help reduce the risk of opioid overdose. As a result of the opioid settlement, DOC has funding available for these expanded MAT services. Consequently, paragraph 2.9.2 e, 2.9.2 h, and 2.9.2 h 1) are amended to require additional resources. It is anticipated these additional resources will result in a decrease in both contractor and DOC staff time responding to overdose events, a decrease in offsite emergency room visits associated with overdoses resulting in a decrease in risk to public safety and will increase staff safety by decreasing exposure to illegal substances.

Additionally, 1 CSR 40-1.050 (8) states, “Contracts awarded as the result of a competitive solicitation may be amended when such an amendment is in the best interest of the state and does not significantly alter the original intent or scope of the contract.” Since the intent of the contract does not change with the amendment, I am proceeding with the amendment to the contract as requested by the state agency.

As a result of the opioid settlement, the state agency has funding specified below available for these expanded MAT services.
